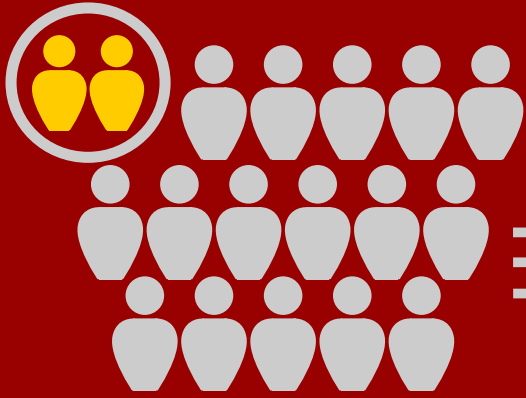


Did Caltech ask you before cutting your health benefits during a pandemic?

We demanded greater transparency and student involvement in selecting our health plan!

- Inform student body of proposed changes and alternative insurance bids and open a comment period before FSHC meets
- Require that a majority of the FSHC vote to approve its student health plan recommendation
- Submit the FSHC's recommendation to the GSC Health Subcommittee for approval
- Publicize FSHC meeting minutes and recommendations to student body
- Provide the FSHC with a cost study of health plan changes to student and Institute finances before it makes its recommendation
